DECATUR GUN CLUB HUNTERS WINGSHOOTING CLINIC INSTRUCTIONS FOR PARTICIPANTS

DATES AND TIMES: Saturday, August 23rd, and Sunday, August 24th (NO PM Session)

Morning Sessions: Check-in time 7:30am – 8:00am Instruction & Shooting 8am – 12pm/noon

Afternoon Sessions: Check-in time 12:30pm – 1:00pm Instruction & Shooting 1pm – 5pm

LOCATION: Decatur Gun Club, 61 Faries Park, Decatur, IL 62526

DIRECTIONS: From I-72 take Exit 144. Turn southwest onto IL Route 48 towards Decatur. Next, turn left onto Brush College Road. Proceed 1¾ miles to the intersection of Brush College Rd. and Reas Bridge Road, then turn left onto Reas Bridge Rd. Proceed 1 mile, then turn right onto Christmas Tree Lane. Next, turn left at the Decatur Gun Club entrance sign.

COST: The fee for each session is \$45 per adult (18 and over) and \$30 per youth (17 and under). **The fee is not refundable.** To secure your reservation, register online and send your completed forms to the address provided below, or email to recegun.40@gmail.com. **The last day reservations will be accepted for the regular Hunters Clinic sessions is Thursday, August 21, 2025.**

APPAREL: Wear upper garments that do not restrict either side-to-side shoulder movement or up and down arm movement. Upper garments should not have snaps, buckles, buttons, or strap adjustments on the front side of the shooting shoulder. Bring a shooting or hunting vest or a shotshell pouch if one is available.

FOOTWEAR: Wingshooting instruction and shotgun shooting are field activities. Wear comfortable but sturdy shoes or boots. No open toed shoes or sandals.

EYE & EAR PROTECTION: Eye and ear protection are mandatory. Participants are expected to provide theirown shooting glasses and ear plugs or earmuffs. Participants who wear prescription glasses or contact lensesshould wear them. Impact resistant safety glasses are required to be worn over prescription glasses if the prescription glasses are not impact resistant. Safety glasses must be worn in addition to contact lenses.

SHOTGUNS & SHOTSHELLS: Bring a field, sporting clays, or skeet shotgun that you're comfortable shooting -any reasonable gauge (410 and 10 gauges are not reasonable). Open chokes are preferable - skeet, improvedcylinder, or light modified are sufficient. Bring 6-8 boxes or 150-200 target shotshells. Target loads in 12 gauge have a 2¾ or 3-dram powder equivalency. Higher powderdram equivalencies will adversely impact your shoulder. Shot sizes of 7½, 8, or 9 only please.

INSTRUCTORS: Wingshooting instruction will be given by National Sporting Clays Association/IDNR Certified Wingshooting Instructors.

SPONSORS: Decatur Gun Club, Decatur Sportsman Association, the Illinois Conservation Foundation, and the Illinois Department of Natural Resources. The IDNR has been involved in training sportsmen and women through its Safety Education Section, by sponsoring wingshooting clinics, through youth hunting programs, and through hunter skills programs for many years. The Decatur Gun Club supports young shooters through its sponsorship of a Scholastic Clay Target Program Shooting Team and co-sponsors the Decatur Gun Club Introductory Wingshooting Clinic in September each year.

SPECIAL NOTES: The Department of Natural Resources or the Wingshooting Instructor will remove any participant from the Wingshooting Clinic for disruptive or unsafe behavior. Wingshooting Clinics do not satisfy the Illinois Hunter Education Requirement.
